







Quick Guide to the IELTS on Computer – Listening, Reading, and Writing Tests

Welcome to the Quick Guide for the IELTS on Computer Listening, Reading, and Writing tests. General Features:

- A **timer** at the top of the screen shows how much time you have left.
- **Instructions** for each part appear in a box at the top of the screen.
- Use the **navigation bar** at the bottom to move from one question to another.
- You can also use the arrows to move forward or back between questions.

Answering and Reviewing:

- Once you answer a question, a **line** will appear above that question in the navigation bar.
- You can **flag** any question to review it later by clicking the **flag icon**.
- To go back to a flagged question, click the question number in the navigation bar.
- To remove a flag, click the flag icon again.
- You can review and change your answers at any time before the test ends.

Scrolling and Screen Settings:

- Use the scroll bar to see all questions.
- To change **text size** or **color settings**, click the **options icon in the top-right corner**.
 - Under 'Contrast', choose:
 - Black on white
 - White on black
 - Yellow on black
 - Under 'Text Size', choose:
 - Regular
 - Large
 - Extra Large
- The options icon remains on the screen throughout the test, so you can change settings anytime.

Audio and Instructions:

- In the Listening test, you can adjust the volume using the control in the bottom-right corner.
- To view the test instructions again, click the **options icon** and select '**Test Instructions**'.

Highlighting and Note-Taking:

- To **highlight text**, left-click and drag your cursor over the desired section, then click **'Highlight'**.
- To remove highlights, click the highlighted text and select 'Delete Highlight'.
- To make notes, highlight the text and click 'Note'. A notes panel will open.
 - Notes are saved automatically.
 - Click the X to hide notes.
 - Click the notes icon or the highlighted section to view them again.
 - To delete a note, click 'Delete', then confirm.

Test Ending:

- When 1 minute remains, the top part of the screen will change color as a warning.
- The test will automatically stop when time runs out.
