S + Adverb of Duration + V + O A really old man briefly helped me.

Conjunctions

e.g., I studied at university after I finished high school.

e.g., Before I studied at university, I finished high school.









Adverb: Briefly/Temporarily -> Adjective: Brief/Temporary + Noun

I believe that + S + V + O

I believe that people temporarily require/use/need/want + plastic bags because they are helpful, especially strong plastic bags.

Adjective + Noun

A brief solution + V + O A temporary solution + V + O

Adverb of Frequency:

S + V + O

Some people often/sometimes accept that + S + V + OMany people rarely/seldom understand that + S + V + O

Conjunctive Adverbs:

S + Conjunctive Adverb + V + O

Education helps people get a job. Many people accordingly believe that education is necessary.

Taxes are good and bad. In my opinion, I consequently agree that paying a fair tax is crucial for everyone.

S + V + O**Education** is important.

S, + Adverb of Focusing, + V + O Education, especially university, is important.

S + V + Adverb of Focusing + O Education is especially important.
