Present Tenses:

Present Simple: Subject + Verb 1 + Object

- Facts
- Habitual routines
- Opinions
- Feelings
- 1. In my opinion, I agree because there are numerous problems with the statement
- 2. Personally, I disagree
- 3. I agree and disagree with the statement.

Present Perfect: Subject + has/have + Verb 3 + Object

The role of women in the workforce has evolved significantly over the years, but gender inequality still exists.









- The role = The position
- 2. Women = females
- 3. In the workforce = in companies
- 4. Has evolved = has changed
- Significantly = a lot
- 6. Over the years = over time / over the decades / over the centuries
- 7. But = however / yet
- 8. Gender inequality = unequal gender
- 9. Still exists = still present

The position of females in companies has changed a lot over time, yet unequal gender rights are still present.

Expressions with the Present Perfect:

- 1. It has been understood that...
- 2. It is widely accepted that...

It has been widely understood that the roles of female employees have changed a lot over time, yet unequal gender rights are still present. In my opinion, I agree because there are numerous problems with the issue, and I will discuss gender inequality further.









Subordinating Conjunction Complex Sentence

- 1. S + V + O + Subordinating Conjunction + S + V + O
- 2. Subordinating Conjunction + S + V + O, S + V + O
 - I think that + S + V + O
 - I believe that + S + V + O

Coordinating Conjunction

1. S + V + O, + Coordinating Conjunction + S + V + O

Zero Conditional (100%)

- If + Subject + Verb 1 + Object, S + V1 + O

First Conditional (50-99%)

- If + Subject + Verb 1 + Object, S + will + V1 + O
