Simple (1st sentence)

S + V + O

Compound:

S + V + O, + Coordinating Conjunction + S + V + O

Complex:

Independent Clause + Dependent Clause

- S + V + O + Subordinating Conjunctions + S + V + O
- Subordinating Conjunction + S + V + O, S + V + O
- S, RP + S + V + O, + V + O.
- S + V + O, RP + S + V + O.

Compound and Complex Sentence:

S + V + O + Coordinating Conjunction + S + V + O +
Subordinating Conjunction + S + V + O
