- a town

an = 1 (an + vowel: a, e, l, o, u)

- an hour
- an apple
- an orange

the = Use the 2nd time

Plural noun (features / facilities / people / children)

### Article + Noun

#### Quantifiers:

- some + countable noun / uncountable
- few + countable noun
- every + singular noun (feature/facility/person) + singular verb (is/was)
- many + countable noun
- much + uncountable noun (Water, oil, gas, flour, sugar, salt, pepper)

#### Quantifier + Noun

### **Examples:**

- **1.** Thailand is a large country in Southeast Asia.
- 2. The Grand Palace in Bangkok is a major tourist site.
- 3. There is an ancient gate in Chiangmai. The gate is beautiful.
- There are many temples in Thailand.
- **5.** Some islands in Thailand are famous for their beaches.
- Every island in Thailand is famous for their beaches.

- Clearly see
- Carefully
- Slowly
- Rapidly
- Efficiently
- Gently
- Firmly

- Definitely / Undoubtedly
- Certainly
- Probably / Possibly
- Clearly

# **Verbs (All-in-one: "Quantity + Event + Time")**

- "Eat, Ate, Eaten"
- Verb 1 eat
- · Verb 2 ate
- Verb 3 eaten
- Verb 4 +s
- Verb 5 +ing

# Subject + Verb + Object

- I/we/they eat breakfast every morning.
- She/he/her/his/your/my family/our family/eats breakfast every morning.

### Grammar:

#### PRESENT PERFECT

- Subject + has/have + Verb 3 + Object

В

- I/we/they/you have studied Japanese.
- She/he/her + noun + has studied Japanese.

Singular or Uncountable Noun + has + Verb 3 + Object (since/for + Time)

- He has taught English for 20 years.
- The red apple has become rotten.
- An apple has become rotten.
- A banana has become rotten.

Plural Noun + have + Verb 3 + Object (since/for + Time)

- We have studied IELTS since 5pm.
- Two apples have become old.









Subject + think/feel/believe + that + Subject + has/have + Verb 3 + O

I think that your English has improved.	
PRESENT CONTINUOUS	
Subject + is/am/are + V~ing + Object	

- I am teaching IELTS.
- are learning about IELTS Listening.
- He/she/it is learning online at the moment.

#### **KEYWORDS**

- Adjective + Noun
  - e.g., The red apple has become rotten.
- Adverb + Verb
  - e.g., I am always studying Japanese these days.
