Subject + (Transitive) Verb 2 + Direct Object

- I gave a book.
- She told me a story.
- The teacher sent an email.
- She purchased a car.
- I ate some pizza.

Quantifier:

- Some
- Many

- My parents read a poem.

Subject + (Transitive) Verb 2 + Direct Object + Indirect Object

- I watched a movie with my mum and dad in the shopping mall yesterday morning.

NOTES:

- A direct object can be:
 1. Noun
 2. Pronoun

O The teacher sent an email to the students.

X The teacher sent to the students an email.

X The teacher sent, to the students, an email. (Poetry/Creative Writing)

e.g., She gave her brother a new novel.

Intransitive Verbs:

Subject + Intransitive Verbs + _____

- I slept peacefully.
- I jogged quickly.
- We arrived early.
- She woke up late.

- I walked to the school.
- I stood near the 7-11.

Transitive and Intransitive Verb

- The teacher went to the park.
- I go to the park.

I run every morning. (Run = exercise)

I run a small coffee shop. (Run = operate)

Prepositions:

- in, at, on
- beside
- opposite
- behind
- below
- under
- over

Advanced Grammar

- I said that the weather is beautiful.

FUTURE TENSES

Future Simple:

Subject + will + Verb 1 + Object

- I will travel to the moon.
- She will study overseas.
- They will eat dinner in the living room this evening.
- The country will reduce taxes for many people.
- I will have dinner after class.

Future Perfect:

Subject + will + have + Verb 3 + Object + when/after/before + S + V + O

- I will have studied for many years when you retire.
- I will have graduated before you arrive back home.
- The family will have saved enough money after you graduate from university.
- I will have eaten dinner after class.

Future Continuous:

Subject + will be + V~ing + Object

- I will be traveling to the moon when you arrive back home.
- They will be studying overseas while we renovate the house.
- They will be eating dinner in the living this evening.
- The country will be reducing taxes for many people.
- I will be having dinner after class.

First Conditional:

If + Subject + Verb 1 + Object + then + S + will + Verb 1 + Object

- If I save money, I will travel to the moon. (Writing)
- If we save money then we will renovate the house. (Speaking/listening)
- If we buy a car then we will have more debt.
- I will travel to the moon if I save money. (Writing)
- We will renovate the house if we save money. (Speaking/listening)
- We will have more debt if we buy a car.
